This guide provides step-by-step instructions to assign, access, and view Diagnostic exam reports

Teachers



- Use your credentials to log in to your BurlingtonEnglish account.
- Select the VTest Management tile from the dashboard.

At the top of the screen teachers will see three tabs:

PRE-ASSIGNED EXAMS STUDENTS REPORTS

1. PRE-ASSIGNED EXAMS

The tab will only appear if:

- Exams were pre-assigned to the teacher's students by the institution administrator.
- Students activated a code from their student's book.

2. STUDENTS

The tab will only appear if students have joined the teacher's class, using a class code.

3. EXAMS/REPORTS

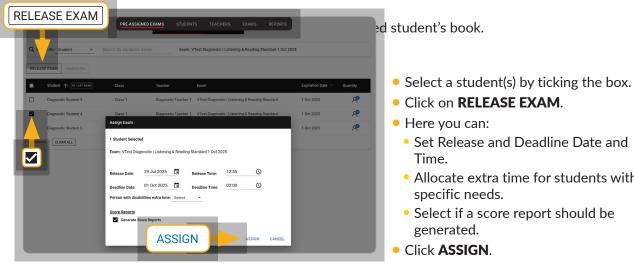


Pre-Assigned Exams Tab



In the **PRE-ASSIGNED EXAMS** tab, you can view your students, and set a release time for the Diagnostic exam.

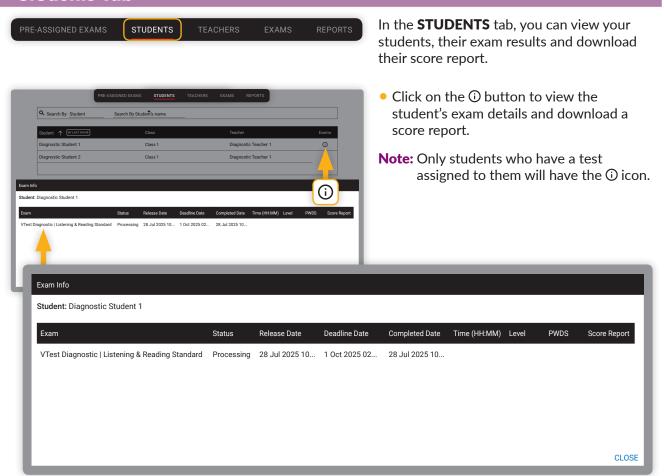
Note: Only students who have completed these two steps will be shown here:



- Click on **RELEASE EXAM**.
- Here you can:
 - Set Release and Deadline Date and Time.
 - Allocate extra time for students with specific needs.
 - Select if a score report should be generated.
- Click ASSIGN.



Students Tab

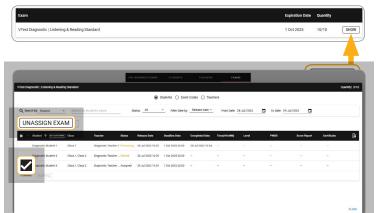




Exams Tab



In the **EXAMS** tab, you can view all your available VTest exams for your institution, along with any that have already expired.



 View the student's status and test details.

Note: The following actions can only be performed on tests that haven't been taken yet, or missed the deadline; Their status will be **Assigned** or **Not Taken**.

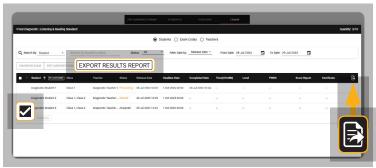
 Unassign exam: Select the student and click on UNASSIGN EXAM.



• Click on **YES** to unassign or **NO** to cancel.



- To edit an exam assigned to a student, select the student and click on EDIT ASSIGNED EXAM.
- Edit test parameters for the specific student, such as:
 - Release and Deadline Dates and Times
 - Form version
 - Allocation of extra time for a student with specific needs
 - Give the student access to the Results App
- Click **ASSIGN**.



You can export a report for one or more students who have completed an exam. The button will only be active with a test status of DONE.

- Select the student(s).
- Click on EXPORT RESULTS REPORT.
 This downloads the report as an Excel document, which shows the student's level and scores for the completed exam.
- To print or export the full list (not only the ones that are done), click on the picon.



Reports Tab



In the **REPORTS** tab, you can access a report to see a class-level overview and each student's performance, arranged by target level.

Institutions that conducted more than one exam in a school year have the ability to compare them.

- Hover over the squares to see which students are included in that particular level.
- Click on the settings ② icon and choose the exam.
